RETENTION OF FIRST PAST THE POST ELECTORAL SYSTEM AND THE RIGHT TO DEMAND A POLL

Notice is given under section 28 (1) of the Local Electoral Act 2001, that Carterton District Council has resolved to retain the First Past the Post (FPP) electoral system for the 2019 and 2022 elections.

Notice is also given that electors of the Carterton District Council have the right to demand a poll on the electoral system to be used.

The choice is between the First Past the Post (FPP) and the Single Transferable Voting (STV) electoral systems. Unless a poll determines otherwise, the FPP electoral system will continue to be used for the Carterton District Council.

A valid demand for a poll must be:

- made in writing
- signed by at least 5 percent (325) of eligible electors of the Carterton District Council
- delivered to the office of the Carterton District Council, 28 Holloway Street, Carterton by 4.00pm Tuesday 19 December 2017.

Every elector who signs a demand must also set out his or her full name and the address for which they are qualified as an elector of the Carterton District Council.
