DECISION

This is an application by J F & K L Yates for an off-licence in respect of premises situated at 60-72 High Street South, Carterton, known as Carterton New World.

The application is in respect of premises in which the principal business is the manufacture and sale of alcohol.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off-licence.

The licence may issue immediately.

The applicant's attention is drawn to ss.55, 56, 57 and 214 (3) of the Act obliging the holder of an off-licence to display:-

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day,
 or before 1 pm on Anzac Day
- b) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm

- c) no alcohol may be sold other than—
 - (i) Beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) Mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or

- (iii) Fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
- (iv) Grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
- (v) A food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted
- d) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons
- e) conditions prescribing steps to be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions
 of this Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed: the
 Host Responsibility Policy must be displayed in view of the public
- f) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample.
