DECISION

This is an application by **Talpa Enterprises Ltd** for a renewal on-licence in respect of premises situated at 9 High Street North, Carterton and known as Balter Bar & Kitchen.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal ON-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

Reminder of conditions as follows:

- 1.Alcohol may be sold on the premises on the following days and during the following hours: Wednesday-Sunday 10.00am-12 midnight
- 2.No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on: Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas day, or before 1pm on Anzac day to any one person as per section 47 of the Act.
- 3. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers at all times: **as per application**
- 4. Food must be available for consumption and actively promoted on the premises at all times, when open for the sale of alcohol, a range of menu choices are to be visible
- 5.A reasonable range of non alcoholic and low alcohol beverages will be available at all times
- 6. The footprint of the business has been varied as per application portion of council side walk is to be included into licensed area

The following steps must be taken to ensure the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:

- 1. Display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons
- 2. Host Responsibility Policy must be displayed in view of the public
- 3. Signs must be prominently displayed detailing information regarding alternate forms of transport.
