## Moving house?

If you move, remember that the bin stays with the house. The bin is owned by the Council and **MUST** remain with the property it was delivered to.

### What can I put in the Green bin?

#### Glass • Plastic • Metal



##### Glass bottles / glass jars

Clean unbroken bottles and jars



##### Plastic containers / remove lids

All household plastic containers displaying recycle symbols 1-7, except for those displaying the symbol 6 EPS  
Washed and squashed, lids removed and placed in the recycle bin



##### Metal cans / tins

Steel and aluminium cans, Metal lids from jars, Empty aerosol cans, Clean aluminium foil  
Washed and squashed



Limit of 2 bins per Ratepayer

#### Washed & squashed

Wash and Squash to give more space in bin and truck

### What can I put in the Red bin?

#### Paper • Cardboard

##### Paper

Newspapers, brown paper, magazines, junk mail, pamphlets, office paper, books, leaflets, telephone directories  
Flattened and grouped



##### Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard, Cardboard boxes, egg cartons  
Flattened and grouped



\*cardboard that doesn't fit in the red bin needs to be dropped to transfer station



#### Flattened & grouped

Place paper and cardboard in a plastic bag to keep dry during winter

### What can't I put in the bins?

To help us to provide you with the best service possible, please do **NOT** put the following in your recycling bins:

#### Glass

- NO Light bulbs
- NO Broken glass
- NO Window glass
- NO Mirrors
- NO Ceramics
- NO Drinking glasses

#### Paper/card

- NO Painted or waxed paper
- NO Wrapping paper
- NO Milk and juice cartons (all types)
- NO

#### Other

- NO Nappies
- NO Foodscraps
- NO Flowers
- NO Paint and rope
- NO Cups, plates, saucers
- NO Toys
- NO Fibreboard

#### Plastics

- NO Plastic films or bags
- NO Muesli bar wrappers
- NO Cereal liners
- NO Coffee refills
- NO Oil containers
- NO Expanded Polystyrene
- NO Meat trays

- NO hazardous material containers eg: pesticides, oil or toxic chemicals

### Kerbside recycling

Kerbside recycling collection is not a complete refuse management system. It will cater for the vast majority of recyclables a household will create in a week.

However it will **NOT** cope with;

- Plastic Bags on the kerbside collection - they can be delivered to transfer station
- Your cardboard boxes after you have changed flat or moved house
- Volumes of bottles & cans after a party
- Commercial volumes - a retailer can put out the milk and drink bottles from their tearoom, but a restaurant cannot put out their wine bottles; equally a bookshop cannot put out large volumes of cardboard.

Please take large quantities to the recycling centre, or arrange for a pickup via a private contractor.
