## **DECISION**

This is an application by **Duffields Foodmarket Ltd** for a Temporary Authority for an offlicence in respect of premises situated at **60-72 High Street South Carterton**, known as **Carterton New World** 

The application is in respect of premises in which the principal business is the manufacture and sale of alcohol.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant a Temporary Authority for an OFF-Licence authorising the sale of liquor.

The applicant's attention is drawn to ss.55, 56, 57 and 214 (3) of the Act obliging the holder of an OFF-Licence to display:-

- A sign attached to the exterior of the premises, so as to be readily read by persons outside each principal entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of liquor;
- 2. A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance;
- 3. A sign prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
