WATER SHUTDOWN NOTICE

G & C Diggers, the Carterton District Council Contractors, is upgrading the watermain in Wakelin Street. In order to proceed with the work, it will be necessary to shut down the water to your residence.

This will take place on:

Thursday 14th June from 5:30pm
to 05:00 am on Friday 15th June 2018.

Please note that further shutdowns will be necessary to complete the project. Please check your letterbox daily.

- If you need water during this period, you should fill up suitable containers before the water is turned off.
- Try not to use the hot taps while the water is off. The hot water cylinder may be damaged if the water level gets too low.
- Do not use washing machines, automatic dishwashers or other appliances that use water during the shut-off period as they may be damaged if used without water.
- In the event of inclement or persistent unfavourable weather, work will be deferred to a later date. You will be notified of this date.
- When the water supply is turned back on, the water may have a milky-white appearance. This is caused by small air bubbles in the water and will not affect taste or quality. We will try to eliminate most of the air from the system when the supply is restored. However, if air is still visible in your water, running a tap for a few minutes should clear it from your pipes.
