- 1,200 postcards distributed
- Over 400 online surveys completed
- 150 community conversations
- 48 participants in 3 focus groups
- 44 in-depth interviews with 60 leaders from business, community, health and government
- An open invitation community meeting attended by 36 leaders to share results and develop priorities moving forward
- Regular updates in community newspapers, mailouts and websites

In March we shared the results of our research and consultation with staff and Elected Members in two workshops and have developed the attached draft strategy.
