What's next

The next steps on the project are to finalise the document for publication and officially launch it to our stakeholders. The target timeframe for launch is late July - we'll keep you posted.

Work by the Councils is already underway to develop the Action Plan to underpin the Strategy and turn its goals into reality. The Action Plan will be shared with the community and reported on as it progresses.
