Greenhouse gas emissions Dashboard - September 2021







Climate data

Earth's average temperature in September 2021 compare to 1951-1980 data: **+0.92°C**

Masterton, September 2021 (main weather station in the Wairarapa):

- Average rainfall compare to 1981-2010: +19.3mm
- Average temperature compare to 1981-2010 : +0.1°C





Did you know?

Weather and climate are two different things. Weather is what conditions of the atmosphere are over a short period of time, and climate is how the atmosphere "behaves" over relatively long periods of time.



Electric Vehicles (EV)


- EV fleet in the Wairarapa in September 2021: 313 ~ +8.7%
- EV fleet in the Wellington region in September 2021: 4,809 ~ +6.7%
- EV fleet in New Zealand in September 2021: 32,492 ~ +7.5% Compare to previous month



Air quality

Masterton, September 2021 (main air quality station in the Wairarapa):

- PM2.5: 10.16 μg/m³ 1 day exceed WHO guidelines (>25 μg/m³)
- PM10: 13.66 μg/m³ 0 day exceeds WHO guidelines (>50 μg/m³)





Electricity

Power consumption (South Wairarapa and Carterton Districts) in September 2021

- Streetlight: 40,000 kWh ≈ 61 houses power consumption⁴
- Water supply: 84,000 kWh ≈ 129 houses
- Wastewater: 66,000 kWh ≈ 101 houses

One house of 4 people consumes about 650 kWh per month

Greenhouse gas emissions from electricity in September 2021:

■ 20.8 tCO₂e ≈ 89 return flights between Wellington and Auckland
