



Carterton District Council Guidelines for UAV (drones) Over Council Reserves

Comply with the Civil Aviation Authorities (CAA) rules relating to the mode of operating UAVs.

Permitted aircraft are those commonly referred to as park flyers and small multi rotors powered by electric engines - no turbine or internal combustion engine types

Be courteous and considerate of other park users

Not operate over playgrounds, swimming baths or a sports field if being played upon by sporting bodies e.g. athletics, soccer.

Parental supervision for children under 16

Be flown in daylight hours only

The operator is responsible for any harm or damage to other park users and Council property with no liability on the Council

Cease operation if requested by Council staff

Any person proposing to use a UAV for commercial purposes, such as filming, must obtain the appropriate permit from council

Any breach of the above conditions could result in termination of the individual's permission
