LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL INFORMATION AND MEETINGS ACT Request: 2022-52

Thank you for your email of 8 September to the Carterton District Council requesting the following information:

"...I would like to apply for a copy of the Consents requirements that New Zealand Motor Caravan Ass (nzmca) have to abide by for the Operating of their Parks under your Management if Applicable..."

On 27 September 2022, you clarified your request, 'Do NZMCA run any Parks for their members under your control.'

Your request has been considered under the Local Government Official Information and Meeting Act 1987 (the Act).

The Freedom Camping Act enables provisions for camping on road reserves. The Council does not require any additional consent requirements beyond the legislation.

Freedom camping is a permitted activity on our rural reserves. Some Carterton reserves have a specific classification, including Carrington Park, which enable / prohibit camping.

The Carterton motor camp is privately administrated. The Council does not have specific consent requirements for motorhomes at this location.
