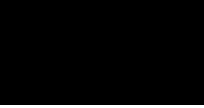

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL INFORMATION AND MEETINGS ACT Request: 2023-68**

We refer to your official information request dated 11 September 2023. Your request was formally transferred in part to Carterton District Council (CDC) from MBIE on 27 September 2023 for the following information:

- 2) *"In the Wairarapa District Council can you supply me how many m3 of water have been sold to Domestic Water carried in the last 12 months,  
a) what areas don't have a council supplied water scheme.  
b) Are there any industrial businesses who rely on water to do delivered. Can you also give the above information for Masterton District Council and Carterton District Council*
- 3) *Could you supply a map of the areas that don't get a council water scheme, from question 2*
- 4) *In the Masterton and Wairarapa could you supply me all the verified water carriers please and how many m3 have been sold to each carrier in the last 12 months. Also include Carterton District Council"*

Your request has been considered under the Local Government Official Information and Meeting Act 1987 (the Act).

Our response to your request is in the number order below.

- 2) ***In the Wairarapa District Council can you supply me how many m3 of water have been sold to Domestic Water carried in the last 12 months.***

Wairarapa consists of three District Councils, these are, South Wairarapa District Council, Carterton District Council, and Masterton District Council.

CDC have supplied approximately 5516m<sup>3</sup> water to a registered water carrier in the last 12 months.

- a) ***What areas don't have a council supplied water scheme.***

**a) Are there any industrial businesses who rely on water to do delivered. Can you also give the above information for Masterton District Council and Carterton District Council.**

Except for one industrial business in Carterton, all industrial businesses outside rural areas have reticulated water supply.

**3) Could you supply a map of the areas that don't get a council water scheme from question 2**

As above, majority of rural areas in Carterton do not have a Council water supply scheme. The Map can be viewed here: <https://cdc.govt.nz/online-services/interactive-maps>.

**4) In the Masterton and Wairarapa could you supply me all the verified water carriers please and how many m3 have been sold to each carrier in the last 12 months. Also include Carterton District Council.**

Move Freight Wairarapa takes water from the Waingawa industrial area in Carterton District.

There are two other registered carriers in Carterton. CDC records do not indicate that water was supplied to these two water carriers in the last twelve months.
