LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL INFORMATION AND MEETINGS ACT Request: 2023-75

Thank you for your email of 10 October 2023 to the Carterton District Council (CDC) requesting the following information:

"...could you please let me know how your Purchase of e-bikes and e-scooters for staff use to encourage active transport mode shift for council employees is going, how is the uptake, which safe routes are your staff taking."

Your request has been considered under the Local Government Official Information and Meeting Act 1987 (the Act).

We have recently purchased two e-bikes and two e-scooters. As there are a number of staff excited to start using the bikes and the scooters, we have created a booking system to track the uptake of bookings made. As this has only just been implemented, we do not yet have information on usage, or routes taken.
