LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL INFORMATION AND MEETINGS ACT Request: 2023-89

Thank you for your email of 27 November 2023 to the Carterton District Council (CDC) requesting the following information:

"I would like to know if there are any current requests/ instructions/ notices to fix for Lot44 (the walkway) to have bollards, fencing, a separation strip, etc."

Your request has been considered under the Local Government Official Information and Meeting Act 1987 (the Act).

The Flat Point Beach Ltd Directors have been previously advised by CDC that it is good practice to separate walkways from driveways and private property. However, this is only a suggestion and is not part of the Council consent conditions for the Flat Point Beach subdivision.

In response to your request, no, there have been no current requests/instructions/notices to fix Lot44 (the walkway) to have bollards, fencing, or a separation strip.
