Thank you for your email of 25 September 2024 to the Carterton District Council requesting the following information:

LGOIMA questions re meeting held 18th September 2024 regarding the Mayors decision to exclude Crs Williams & Cherry-Campbell on grounds of pre determination and bias/conflict of interest.

- 1) Can you please provide any/all advice (internal or external) or evidence that was sought/received by the Mayor and/or Deputy Mayor (including date and time stamped) prior to the meeting regarding both the perceived issues raised by the Deputy Mayor (pre determination, bias, conflicts of interest etc) and the decision of the Mayor to exclude Crs Williams & Cherry-Campbell?
- 2) Were Council Standing Orders and/or Local Government processes followed correctly in the Council meeting?
- 3) Was the decision of the Mayor to exclude Crs Williams & Cherry-Campbell constitutionally appropriate and in line with Council Standing Orders?
- 4) Were any statements/comments made by the Mayor and/or Deputy Mayor at the meeting (as recorded) later found to be inaccurate or factually/procedurally incorrect?
